We the undersigned landowners hereby establish our intentions regarding the Falls Creek Road which runs through and across the property of each of us. Recognizing that Falls Creek Road is a public road, it is our intention to provide this means to assure that it will remain open and accessible to the public.

It is our intention that the Falls Creek Road remain in its present and historic location as it crosses each of our properties. We recognize that a survey of the roadway may at some future time become necessary, however for our purpose herein it can be described in the following manner: From County Road 203 it runs upward along the top of the cliff line then just west of the small reservoir at Falls Creek, and crosses Falls Creek. From that point on the road follows the creek within approximately 40 feet from the center of the roadway to the creek.

To the end that the above described roadway remain open we dedicate to the public use a 60 foot wide easement across each of our properties. This agreement shall be binding on the present owners, their heirs and assigns.
